**Radium System:** Warren explained the need for an additional \$57,710.00 to complete the installation of the system. Guttersohn motioned to approve the additional \$57,710.00 to complete the radium system install; seconded by Chapman. Roll Call: Ayes: Kinaitis, Chapman, Childers, Guttersohn, Orr, McDowell and Bessenbacher. Nays: None. Motion Passed.

**4 Way Stop Light:** Warren explained the need for old wiring replacement at the cost of \$900.00. Guttersohn motioned to approve the new wiring for the 4 way stop light at the cost of \$900.00; seconded by Kinaitis. Roll Call: Ayes: Kinaitis, Chapman, Childers, Guttersohn, Orr, McDowell and Bessenbacher. Nays: None. Motion Passed.

**3 Way Stop Signs:** Warren said that we can install stop signs on S Saginaw St curving into E Silver Lake with S Byron Rd branching off for \$516.20. County would do the install and Reed gave the traffic counts of S Byron Rd-2882 per day, E Silver Lake Rd-3948 per day and S Saginaw St-4278 per day. Guttersohn motioned to approve installation of the stop signs for \$516.20; seconded by Chapman. Roll Call: Ayes: Kinaitis, Chapman, Childers, Guttersohn, Orr, McDowell and Bessenbacher. Nays: None. Motion Passed.


**Public Comments:** None
